

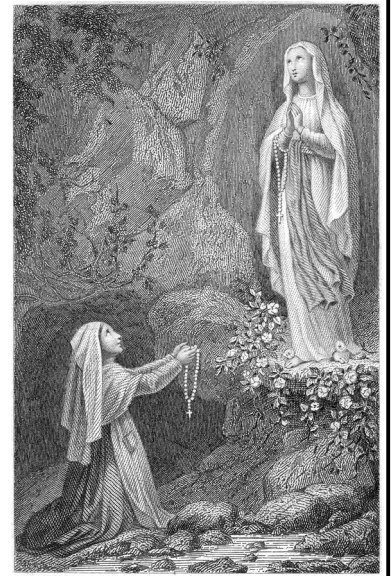

DEAR PARISHIONERS, PRAISED BE JESUS CHRIST! It is good to be back with you here in Kentucky! Thank you for the prayers for my home visit. It was great to see mom and the family. It was nice and relaxing. I think I ate too much as usual when I go home. This weekend, I am at All Saints for my final weekend there. Starting this Tuesday, July 9th, I will be with you full time. I announced the Mass schedule a while back. I did make a couple of adjustments since then. Except for Wednesdays, we will have 6:30 am and 12:10 pm daily Mass. Wednesday mornings I have Mass at the convent since I am still the chaplain of the Sisters of St. Joseph the Worker. On Wednesdays, we will still have a 12:10 pm Mass. Another update is that on the 1st and 3rd Saturdays, we will have morning Mass at Our Lady of Lourdes at 9am. On the 2nd, 4th, and 5th Saturdays, we will have morning Mass at the Holy Family Oratory. Our Sunday Mass schedule is 7am (Low), 9am (Low), & 11:30 am (High) Mass at Our Lady of Lourdes. For the foreseeable future, we will also be having Mass at Holy Family Oratory at 6:30 am on Sundays. Fr. Conor Kunath would like to have the 7am Mass at Our Lady of Lourdes for a while. Please note that this is not permanent, and the Oratory Mass could be canceled suddenly because Fr. Conor is not able to have the Mass at Our Lady of Lourdes. Confessions will be available a half hour before each daily Mass, and hour before each Sunday Mass, and after the 9am Mass on Saturdays until finished. Fr. Conor can't commit to arriving an hour before, but he will hear some once he arrives. I should be back to Our Lady of Lourdes at 8am to start hearing confessions. Next week, Sunday, July 14th, we will have a celebration for our parish anniversary. I look forward to celebrating with you. Once again, it is good to be with you here.

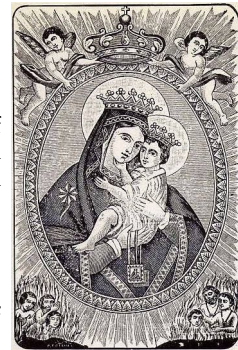

FIRST DAY: JULY 7
