HIS PAST WEDNESDAY, we had a Parish Council meeting. A few issues that you have brought up to the Council were addressed. One of the issues was that I have been spending too much time in the confessional, and sometimes Holy Mass is late. While this has always been a practice of

mine, I will be more sensitive to your time. I will end hearing confessions 5 minutes before Mass begins to get vested and start Holy Mass on time. One of the other concerns was just the opposite, namely, that I haven't been spending enough time in the confessional. I have been getting in the confessional about 20 minutes before Holy Mass begins on the weekdays. To solve this, I will get there earlier. I will be in the confessional at 6:00 am and 11:30 am for daily Mass. As far as the weekend Masses, I will do my best to be in the box an hour before each Mass time. The only issue is when I have the Oratory Mass and then come back for the 9:00 am Mass. There is not a lot of time to hear confessions then. I have been starting Mass late when this happens, for I try to hear some confessions. The same rule will apply. I will hear a few confessions until 5 minutes before Holy Mass. As always, I will be glad to hear your confessions after Mass. After Mass, just line up like you usually do for confession so I know to go in the box. (I have my head down, so I do not know who is in line when I pass by).

A couple other issues were in regards to finances. Someone raised a concern that it was communicated that we do not have funds for any events, one of them being Octoberfest. I am not sure why some thought that. It is not true. I am more than



Shannon. Then, the balance was about 224K. Now, it is about 204K after paying some recent bills. We are holding steady.

The other concern about finances was that when the expenses in the bulletin were listed a couple months ago, there was no line item for the Missionaries for 'Rent' for the use of Our Lady of Lourdes. This is because there still is not an agreement between the Missionaries and the Diocese written up yet. There is a verbal agreement between myself and Fr. Shannon. The agreement is that we do not pay rent, but the parish will take care of any capital expenses, if needed.

These were the main issues that were brought up. If you have any other issues, feel free to contact me. I am more than happy to address and fix any issue you may have, if I can. My door is always open. Feel free to call, text, email, or stop me after Mass, anytime. I appreciate all the prayers and kindness you have shown me. Thank you for your patience and understanding. I am happy to be here with you. Please be assured of my continued prayers. Also, let's continue to keep our beloved Missionaries in prayer, as well.
